

- Water Budgets represent the total water required for efficient use indoors and outdoors based on the best available data and science.
- When multiple water sources are available, such as District-supplied water and groundwater from a private well, the Water Budget remains constant, providing efficient total water use for the property.
- This property-specific guidance for conserving water while maintaining landscaping and the semi-rural atmosphere of the community is valuable for customers, and the District as it plans for communitywide water needs and compliance with State water use regulations.
- Water Budgets are not connected to water rates, fees, or charges.
